I am enclosing a letter I have received from Mr. George V. McGowan, Chairman of the Board of Baltimore Gas and Electric (BG&E), notifying me that they will submit their plan of action to address declining performance at Calvert Cliffs by April 7, 1989. This is a change from the earlier submission date of early March.

I am primarily interested in receiving as comprehensive a plan from BG&E as possible. Given their stated objectives to ensure broad-based participation and support within the line organization and to involve their new Vice President - Nuclear Energy, I have no objection to this revised date.

The NRC's Congressional Affairs staff will continue to keep your staff informed of our activities concerning Calvert Cliffs.
