The purpose of this modification is to amend Section C.1.2, Scope of Work, Task 1: NPRDS Access Codes, to allow for 3 access codes for the NRC National Laboratory contractors instead of 2. Accordingly, the contract is modified to read as follows:

Section C.1.2, Scope of Work, Task 1: NPRDS Access Codes, is deleted in its entirety and the following paragraph is substituted in lieu thereof:

"Task 1: NPRDS Access Codes.

INPO shall provide up to twenty access codes to the NRC NPRDS Coordinator for distribution to the NRC staff and National Laboratory contractors. Up to three of the twenty access codes shall be available for use by NRC National Laboratory contractors to support applicable contracted projects. Other contractors will not be allowed direct access to the NPRDS data base. The NRC NPRDS Coordinator shall be responsible for the assignment, termination and security of the access codes provided by INPO. Upon request, the NRC NPRDS Coordinator will provide INPO with a listing of access code assignments."

All other terms and conditions of the contract remain unchanged.
