Dear Mr. Sreniawski:

This is in response to your letter dated March 23rd, advising me of two violations with regard to the conditions of our NRC Licenses.

Under the conditions of our NRC License No. 24-19486-01, the leak test of our Cobalt-60 teletherapy source was performed on February 15, 1989 and counted on February 27th. A copy of this leak test is enclosed. To avoid further violations, Mr. Debus, the consulting radiation physicist who performs the monthly spot checks on the teletherapy unit, has agreed to wipe the collimator vanes and source drawer at the time he performs the July and January monthly spot checks and will indicate that the wipes have been taken on the monthly spot check report. I believe that full compliance with regard to this violation has been achieved.

Under the conditions of our NRC License No. 24-19486-02, we are required to measure the exposure rate 3 feet from the surface of a package containing radioactive material and also at the surface. These readings must be recorded. This will be done and recorded on the "Package Receipt and Monitor Log," which has been modified slightly from Exhibit 12 of Regulatory Guide 10.8 dated August 1987. A copy of our log is enclosed. I believe that full compliance with regard to this violation has been achieved as of the date of this letter.
