
Dear Mr. Thadani:

The purpose of this letter is to provide our response to Mr. Stello's request for information regarding settlement agreements for discrimination matters arising under Section 210 of the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974, as amended. Our research shows there have not been any settlements between Pennsylvania Power & Light Company and any of its employees in Section 210 proceedings.

We understand the Commission's concern over inclusion of clauses in these agreements which restrict the ability of employees to provide information about potential safety issues to the NRC. It is PP&L's policy to address all legitimate concerns and allegations regarding potential safety issues, regardless of the source, in a forthright manner and without reprisal. Personnel, including contractor employees, are expected to report their safety concerns and PP&L management expects these concerns to be addressed and satisfactorily resolved. Therefore, no one at PP&L will ever be penalized for raising a safety concern to any level (PP&L or NRC).
