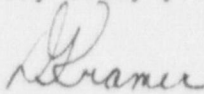

SUMMARY

① Mr. Stephens was asked to clarify item 6 of his re-submitted application dated 3/18/88. - Mr. Stephens stated that item 9 of amendment No. 44 was appropriate except for No. (6). He stated that "Distribution in devices specified in Condition 10. of this license" puts a financial burden because of repeat amendments every time they need to add a device. He asked for a generic condition. Mr. Stephens was told that a condition such as:

"Distribution of devices manufactured by ~~Process Automation Business~~ Process Automation Business (Accuray), and that are registered pursuant to section 32.210 of 10CFR part 32 and contained in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Registry of sealed sources and devices to persons authorized to receive the material pursuant to terms and conditions of a specific license issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission or an Agreement State." ; will be considered after conference
