On February 25, 1989, North Anna Unit 1 experienced a steam generator tube leak in the C steam generator. Attached please find two versions (proprietary and non-proprietary) of our initial report documenting this event entitled "North Anna Unit 1 Steam Generator Leak Event Report, Revision 0, dated April 26, 1989."

The proprietary version of the report contains information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation. It is supported by an affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of Commission's regulations.


