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

Enclosed are four sets (2 volumes/set) of the "Amended Preservice Inspection Summary Report for Class 1 and Class 2 Pressure Retaining Components at the South Texas Project Electric Generating Station - Unit 2". This amended summary report documents the PSI weld examinations performed on South Texas Project Electric Generating Station-Unit 2 (STPEGS-2) prior to commercial operation (June 19, 1989), including the examinations performed subsequent to our filing of the original Unit 2 PSI weld summary report on October 10, 1988 (ST-HL-AE-2807). Changes to the original Unit 2 PSI weld summary report have been indicated by a bar mark in the margin. This amended PSI summary report documents HL&P's completion of the STPEGS-2 PSI examinations required by the ASME Section XI Code for welds in Class 1 and Class 2 components and the augmented inspection programs, as described in this report.
