Dear Mr. Chairman:

On March 18, 1989, the former Chairman, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Mr. Lando W. Zech, Jr., requested that the General Services Administration (GSA) assign Federal Protective Officer's (FPO's) to your facility located at One White Flint Program.

That request was approved with the stipulation that these officers would remain at the facility for a period of one year to provide an orderly transition of your security program as a street, Washington, D.C. Since the Matomic Building, 1717 H complete, we are advising you that GSA intends to terminate the FPO detail to One White Flint North effective October 1, 1989. We will continue to provide protection services which include periodic FPO patrols and emergency response to your building on a past, should the NRC require temporary security assistance for Federal Protection Division will provide FPO's to augment your existing security force.
