Dear Mr. Chairman:

On March 18, 1989, the former Chairman, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Mr. Lando W. Zech, Jr., requested that the General Services Administration (GSA) assign Federal Protective Officer's (FPO's) to your facility located at One White Flint North in Rockville, Maryland, in support of NRC's security program.

That request was approved with the stipulation that these officers would remain at the facility for a period of one year to provide an orderly transition of your security program as a result of your agency's move from the Matomic Building, 1717 H Street, Washington, D.C. Since the transition period is complete, we are advising you that GSA intends to terminate the FPO detail to One White Flint North effective October 1, 1989. Although an FPO will not be permanently assigned to the facility, we will continue to provide protection services which include periodic FPO patrols and emergency response to your building on a 24 hour, 7 days per week basis. As we have indicated in the past, should the NRC require temporary security assistance for occasions such as demonstrations or sensitive hearings, the Federal Protection Division will provide FPO's to augment your existing security force.
