Dear Mr. Moore:

Enclosed please find an Application for License to Export Nuclear Material and Equipment (Form NRC-7) for Energy Fuels Nuclear, Inc., ("Energy Fuels"). In this application, Energy Fuels seeks authority to:

1. Ship natural uranium concentrates ( $U_3O_8$ ) in the form of yellowcake to Cameco's Blind River conversion facility for conversion into uranium hexafluoride ( $UF_6$ ).
2. Ship a portion of the  $UF_6$  from Cameco to Eurodif SA and Urenco Limited for enrichment and to return such enriched nuclear material to the United States after enrichment at Eurodif SA or Urenco Limited.
3. Ship the remaining  $UF_6$  from Cameco to the United States for enrichment.

The parties to this application are the same as the suppliers included in our previous license. They include Energy Fuels, Umetco Minerals Corporation (Post Office Box 669, Blanding, Utah 84511) and Bingham Canyon Recovery Unit (9090 West Bingham Highway, Post Office Box 152, Bingham Canyon, Utah 84006).
