
I attended and successfully completed the Ronan Course including:

7. Training for responsibilities of R.P.O.

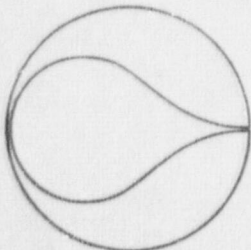
The class was presented in 1986. The instructor for the class was Greg Stephens of Ronan Engineering Company and was nine (9) hours in duration.
