
PETITION FOR REVIEW

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, through its Attorney General James M. Shannon, the Seacoast Anti-Pollution League, the New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution and the Town of Hampton, New Hampshire, hereby petition the Court for review of and to set aside the final agency action of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") authorizing issuance of a license ("low-power license") permitting operation of the Seabrook Station Nuclear Power Plant at up to five percent of rated power. That action is contained in Public Service Co. of New Hampshire (Seabrook Station, Units 1 and 2), CL1-88-10, 28 NRC 573 (1988) conditionally authorizing the issuance of a low-power license for Seabrook. Those conditions were met by the January 30, 1989 decision of the NRC licensing board,


Public Service Co. of New Hampshire (Seabrook Station, Units 1 and 2), LBP-89-04, 29 NRC 62 and by the May 3, 1989 approval by the NRC Staff of certain decommissioning funding issues.




