Following is our response to your above referenced Notice of Violation following your inspection of April 11, 1989.

- A. All nuclear medicine personnel have again been instructed on the prohibition of the storage or use of foodstuffs in areas where radioactive materials are used or stored. In addition, we will increase one in-house surveillance in this regard to assure that this requirement is followed.
- B. The personnel involved have again been instructed in the requirements relative to Mo breakthrough measurements. This included a specific reminder that measurement alone is not sufficient, the requirement includes the mathematical calculation to quantify the Mo activity present before administration to patients. We will increase our in-house surveillance on this issue to assure continuing compliance.
