SUBJECT: CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION FOR AMENDMENT APPLICATION DATED  
APRIL 24, 1989

By letter dated April 24, 1989, KM requested an amendment to License No. STA-583 to authorize dismantling of Building 12. The dismantling activities will be performed in accordance with procedures and controls that have provided adequate environmental protection and worker protection for similar activities. Dismantling of the building will not increase the potential for contamination to spread offsite. Accordingly, the staff has concluded that the following conditions have been met:

1. There is no significant change in the type or significant increase in the amount of any effluents that may be released offsite,
2. There is no significant increase in individual or cumulative occupational radiation exposure,
3. There is no significant construction impact, and
4. There is no significant increase in the potential for or consequences from radiological accidents.

Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11), neither an Environmental Assessment nor an Environmental Impact Statement is warranted for this proposed action.
