In response to the referenced ANPR, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) endorses the detailed comments submitted to you by the Nuclear Management and Resources Council (NUMARC) in their letter of June 26, 1989.

FPL shares the Commission's desire that the commercial nuclear industry have procurement and product acceptance processes that help ensure that fraudulent, counterfeit or substandard components are not used. We believe that current quality assurance practices establish the fundamental requirements necessary to provide such assurance, and that these requirements generally have been implemented effectively. We also recognize the need to continually search for ways to improve the implementation of quality assurance in the procurement process. Because the industry is already working through NUMARC to address procurement issues, we believe that new regulatory requirements, especially rulemakings, are not warranted at this time.
