



In order to complete an evaluation of United Nuclear's request for approval for continued sand backfill operations at the Church Rock Mine, beyond the current expiration date of January 31, 1982 are you amenable to making the following commitments?

1. Submittal of monthly progress reports pertaining to the hydrological and geochemical aspects of modeling addressing the long-term; any potential rate of increase of backfill material (i.e. greater than 12,000 tons average per month) should also be addressed.

2. Submittal of complete modeling results by September 30, 1982.
