Dear Mr. Brown,

This letter is to notify you that Silicon General Caribbean, Inc. has ceased operation of Krypton 85 Tracer Flo testing. The facility at Aguada West Industrial Site, Bldg. #2 in Aguada, Puerto Rico stopped all operations on December 31, 1985.

The Tracer Flo equipment, Trio Tech Model Number 30010-1A, was sold and shipped to the buyer in March 1986. The Krypton 85 gas was removed from the test equipment and transferred to Silicon General, Garden Grove to be used in similar equipment under California Radioactive Material License Number 3514-30.
