

QUESTION (3)

Does the NRC plan any remedial or enforcement action as a result of your findings on these allegations?

ANSWER

As identified in the enclosures to Question (2)(b), the NRC has cited the licensee for several violations as a result of our findings from review of the allegations. Many of the concerns are still being inspected by the Regional staff or investigated by OI. One issue concerning alleged employment discrimination resulted in the convening of an Enforcement Board to consider enforcement action. The Board concluded that additional information was needed and requested that an inspector perform additional inspection. As a result of the additional information obtained, the case was referred to OI for a detailed investigation (see Enclosure (3)-1 through -5).

Other preliminary findings of inspections conducted concerning still-open allegations have indicated that some violations may be issued as identified in the status section of Enclosure (2)(b)-34, and Documents 34a through 34e).

Review for enforcement actions of ongoing OI investigations have not been performed. These cases will be reviewed as soon as the investigations are completed and the reports are issued.

On July 7, 1988 OI issued a report covering the allegations concerning the manager alleged to have been unfit for duty. That report is currently being reviewed by our enforcement staff to determine whether any regulatory action is appropriate based on the report's findings.

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
