This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. H. Neisler of this office on April 25-28, 1989, of activities at Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating License No. NPF-58 and NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-149 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. E. Riley and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to examine the preservation of Unit 2 structures, components and materials during the extended construction delay.
