This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Messrs. K. R. Ridgway, W. G. Rogers, and S. Stasek of this office on February 3 to April 12, 1989, of activities at Fermi 2 authorized by Facility Operating License No. NPF-43 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. B. Ralph Sylvania at the conclusion of the inspection. The inspection examined the licensee's response to railcar door design deficiencies identified at the Pilgrim Station.


