This letter is being sent to invite you to attend a Power Reactor Operator Licensing Seminar planned by the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region I.

The purpose of the seminar is to discuss recent changes to the format for both the requalification examinations and initial examinations and other topics as indicated on the enclosed agenda.

The seminar will be held on May 31, 1989, at the Valley Forge Convention Center complex, North Gulph Road and First Avenue, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania. A seminar agenda is enclosed. When the list of speakers is finalized, we will provide you with an updated agenda.

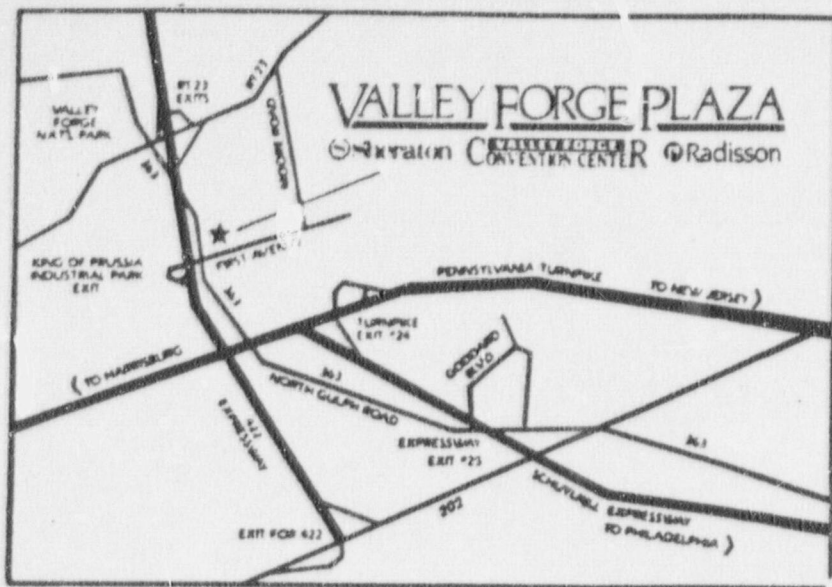

**DIRECTIONS:**

**FROM PHILADELPHIA:** Take Schuylkill to Exit #25 (Goddard Blvd.). Bear right at first light onto Goddard Blvd. Turn right at next light onto North Gulph Road and proceed to First Ave.

**FROM PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE:** Take Turnpike Exit #24 (Valley Forge). Immediately take first exit after toll (Exit 25-Valley Forge) to First Ave.

**FROM ROUTE 202:** Take Pottstown Exit (422 West) to first exit (Bridgeport-Route 23 East). Turn right at first light (Moore Rd.). Turn right at next light (First Ave.) to Hotel and Convention Center.

**FROM ROUTE 422 EAST:** Take King of Prussia Industrial Park Exit to Hotel and Convention Center.

**BY AIR:** All major airlines fly into Philadelphia International Airport. Liberty Cab & Limousine, (215) 365-8414, provides limousine service every hour on the hour for the 45 minute ride to Valley Forge Plaza and Valley Forge Convention Center. Cost: 11.50 per person, one way. (Rates subject to change.) Register at the Liberty booth in the terminal.

**BY BUS:** SEPTA, (215) 574-7800, Route #45 bus departs daily from Center City Philadelphia at both 16th and JFK Blvd. and at the 29th Street side of 30th Street Station. The bus stops at the King of Prussia Shopping Plaza and at the Hotel and Convention Center.

**BY TRAIN:** AMTRAK, (215) 824-1600, provides frequent and regular service from major metropolitan areas throughout the country to Philadelphia. The train arrives at 30th Street Station. SEPTA bus (#45) leaves the station every half hour on weekdays. See above.

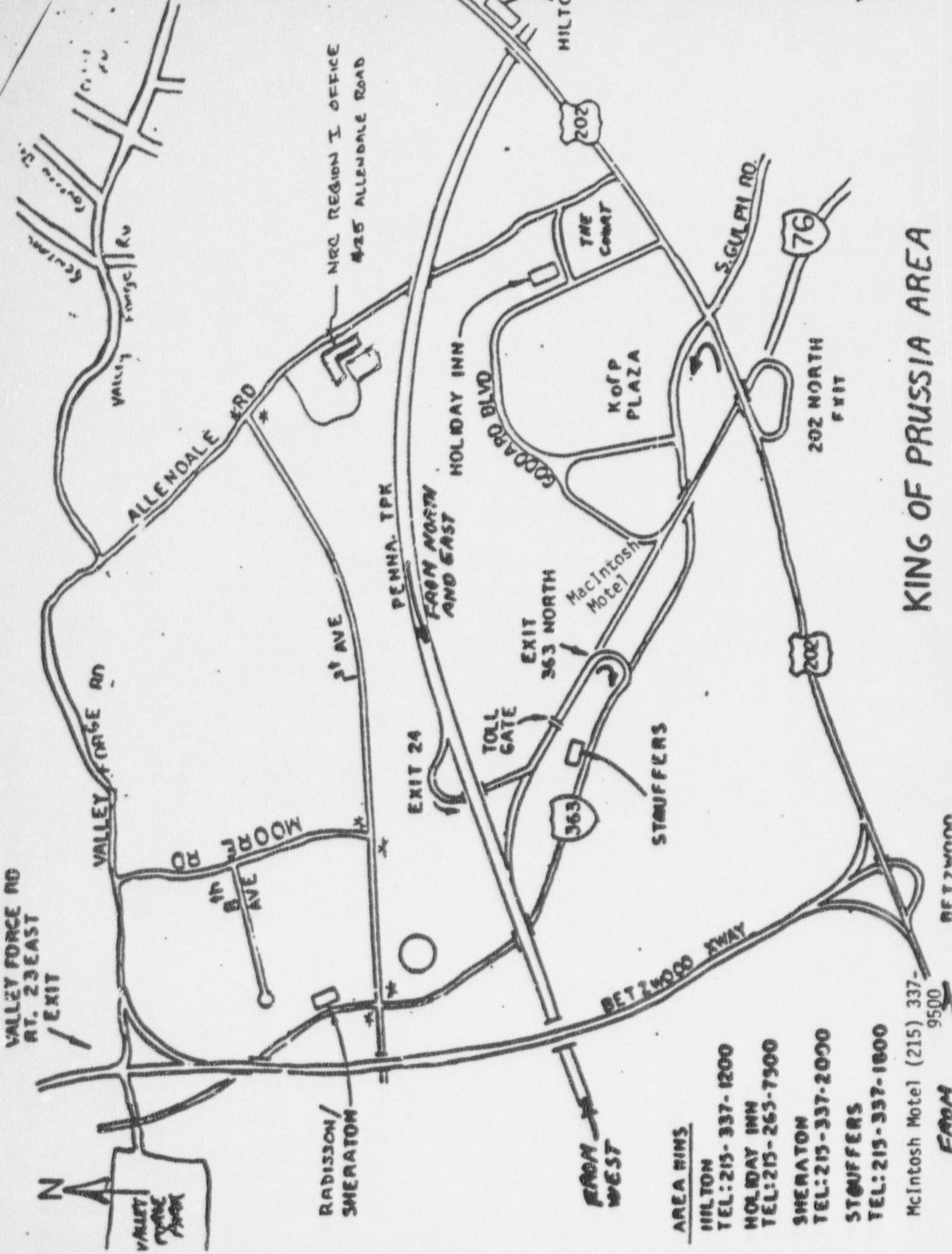

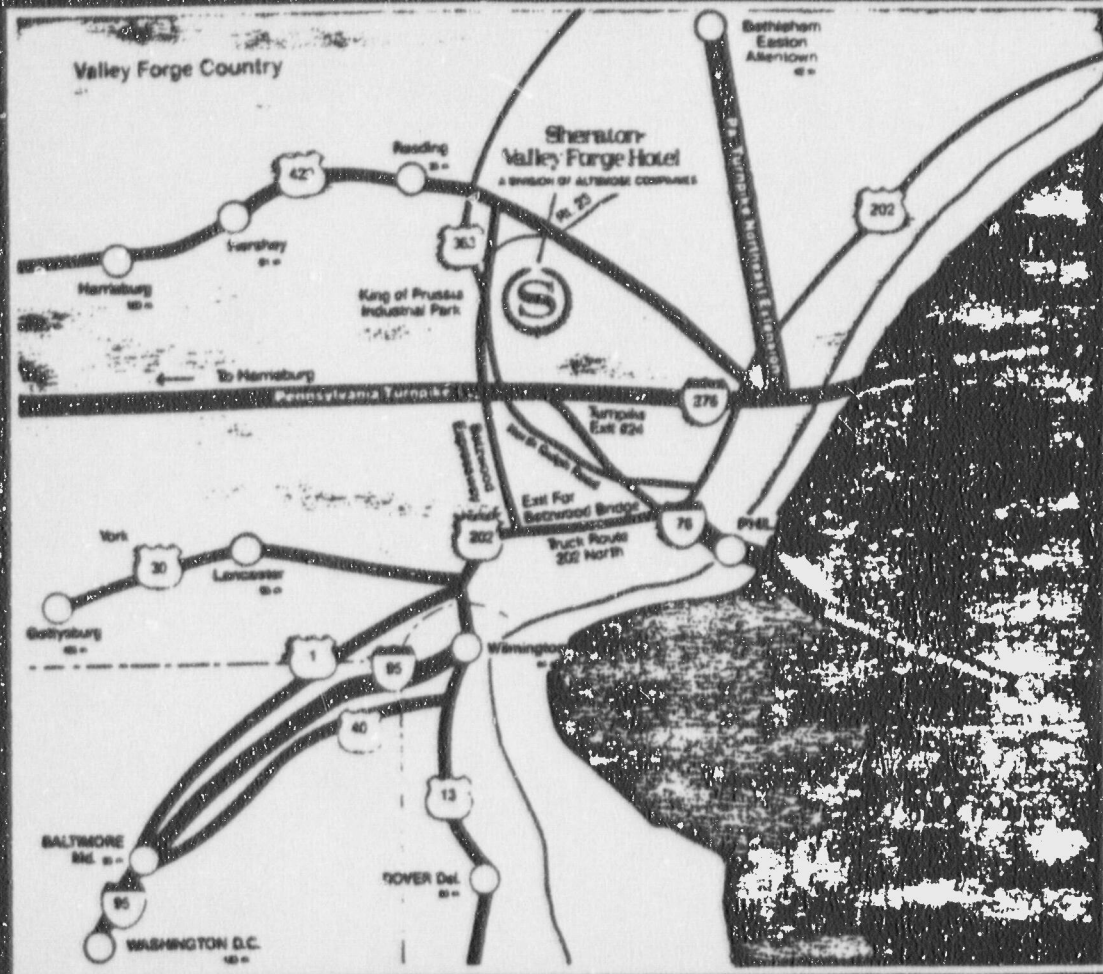

## DIRECTIONS TO THE SHERATON-VALLEY FORGE HOTEL



**BY AUTOMOBILE:** FROM THE EAST & WEST. Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to the Valley Forge Exit (#24). FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH. Take I-95 to U.S. 202 North FROM PHILADELPHIA. Take the Schuylkill Expressway West. From any above Route, the Sheraton-Valley Forge is no more than 3 minutes away by taking Route 363 into North Gulph Road North to the Intersection at First Avenue.

**BY AIR:** All Major Airlines fly into Philadelphia International Airport. LIBERTY CAB & LIMOUSINE (215-365-8414) leaves from Baggage Pickup every 1/2 hour, with a stop at THE SHERATON VALLEY FORGE HOTEL.
