

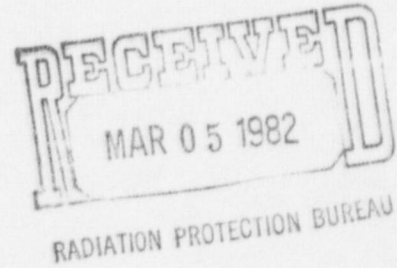

Please refer to our recent telephone conversation regarding additional delays in transmittal of the additional information required by the EID for the Kerr-McGee relicensing report.

The NRC has refused to grant us a delay for submittal of additional information for the Radiological Contingency Plans ordered by NRC for our facilities at Cimarron and Sequoyah. As a result, we must direct our efforts to preparation of this information as soon as possible. Since our staff is limited, we will necessarily have to delay the preparation of the additional information requested by EID. We currently expect that all of the remaining information can be submitted to EID by the end of April, 1982. If you have any questions or need any additional information, please let me know.
