This letter is being sent to invite you to attend a Power Reactor Operator Licensing Seminar planned by the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region I.



DIRECTIONS:

FROM ROUTE 422 EAST: Take King of Prussia Industrial Park Exit to Hotel and Convention Center.


BY AIR: All major airlines fly into Philadelphia International Airport. 
