New Hampshire Yankee hereby certifies that the required onsite property damage insurance is effective as of May 23, 1989, by virtue of the following insurance policies:

First Layer - Primary \$500 Million

o A \$500 million policy with American Nuclear Insurers (ANI) and Mutual Atomic Energy Liability Underwriters (MAELU).

Second Layer - \$500 Million to \$1 Billion

- O A \$120 million policy with ANI
- O A \$380 million policy with Nuclear Electric Insurance Limited (NEIL II)

Third Layer - Excess of \$1 Billion

O A \$60 million policy with NEIL II
