NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of Sacramento Municipal Utility District (the licensee) to withdraw its June 13, 1986 application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-54 for the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station, located in Sacramento County, California.

The proposed amendment would have revised the Technical Specifications pertaining to Licensee Event Report clarifications in accordance with Generic Letter 83-43.

The Commission has previously issued a Notice of Consideration of "suance of Amendment published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on May 6, 1987 (52 FR 16955).

However, by letter dated May 10, 1989, the licensee withdrew the proposed change.
