

Revision 1 to Licensee Event Report 97-009
Main Steam Safety Valve Setpoints Found Outside Required Tolerance

Pursuant to 10CFR50.73, the South Texas Project submits the attached revision to Unit 1 Licensee Event Report 97-009 regarding Main Steam Safety Valve setpoints found outside required tolerances. This event did not have an adverse effect on the health and safety of the public.

This revision reports the results of special testing performed on Main Steam Safety Valves to confirm the effectiveness of corrective actions taken to preclude valve lift outside required tolerances. The corrective actions were not validated. Therefore, this report discusses additional actions to address this issue. Changes are indicated by revision bars. Another supplement to this licensee event report will be submitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission by August 1, 1998 to discuss the results of the root cause investigation and long term corrective actions.

In addition to the commitment to supplement this report by August 1, 1998, the other commitments made in the original licensee event report are revised as indicated in the corrective action section of the attachment to this letter.
