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
Item 2. results from a request to the Radioisotope and Radiation Safety Committee by Drs. Go and Saha of Nuclear Medicine, to permit the use of Mo99-Tc99m generators at 4 Curies per purchase order with a limit of 8 Curies total for the laboratory. These radioactive materials have been approved (pending license amendment) by our Radioisotope and Radiation Safety Committee for clinical studies as are currently being done routinely in Nuclear Medicine using a local radiopharmacy as supplier.


Since these items are needed to satisfy our license requirements beginning in the second quarter and to provide patient care, a timely response is requested.
