I wish to appeal FOIA 88-518 request denial of the documents set forth in Appendices B and D. Copy of said appendices are annexed hereto.

We represent several individuals including

[REDACTED] who worked at
Burroughs OEM Corporation on Mt. Bethel Road, Warren Township
between 1960 and 1983, when the plant closed.

Many of these individuals have acquired breast cancer, thyroid tumors and some have even died as a result of alleged radiation exposure. Many were unaware of the fact that they were working on or around radioactive material.

We are in the process of retaining an expert to determine whether or not these individuals had radiation exposure, and what effects the radiation had on their health. To this end, we are in need of the personal dosimetry records of these individuals.


