MEMO TO: Radiopharmaceutical Carrier FROM: Radiation Safety Officer

SUBJECT: Delivery of Packages Containing Radioactive Material

You have been given a key to the Nuclear Medicine facility and Radiopharmacy for delivery of packages. When delivering packages containing radioactivity, packages should be taken directly to the Nuclear Medicine Radiopharmacy. The Department door and Radiopharmacy door should be unlocked, the package placed in the designated receipt area and the doors immediately relocked.

If the package appears to be damaged, immediately contact one of the individuals identified below. Remain at the facility until it can be determined that neither you, the driver, nor the delivery vehicle is contaminated.


