Dear Mr. Congel:

Enclosed is a copy of the remedial exercise report of the June 14, 1989, remedial exercise which corrected the deficiency identified at the Lower Pottsgrove Township Emergency Operations Center (EOC) during the Limerick offsite radiological emergency preparedness exercise conducted on April 5, 1988.

The one deficiency resulted because the overall response capability demonstrated by Lower Pottsgrove Township was not adequate to ensure that the health and safety of the residents could be protected. Although the Montgomery County response staff simulated taking appropriate actions for the municipality, the lower Pottsgrove Township (EOC) was never properly staffed.

Based on the results of the April 5, 1988, full-participation exercise and the June 14, 1989, remedial exercise, the offsite radiological emergency preparedness for the Limerick Generating Station is adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of an accident.
