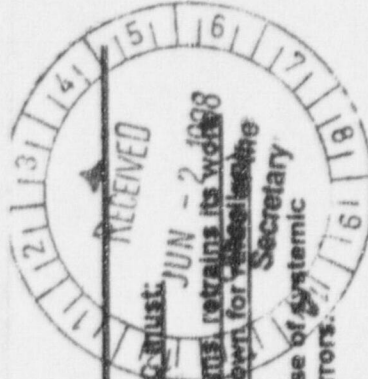
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NRC: CLEAN UP VERMONT YANKEE'S ACTI

The people demand responsible oversight from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. NRC must:

- ♦ HALT VERMONT YANKEE'S RESTART until the corporation corrects all safety problems, retrains its workforce, and demonstrates a commitment to follow the law. (The reactor is presently down for vessel inspection.)
- ♦ Enforce the Regulations! PUT VERMONT YANKEE ON THE NRC WATCH LIST because of systemic mismanagement and lack of compliance with its blueprints. No more smoke and mirrors.
- ♦ HOLD A HEARING IN THE EFFECTED COMMUNITY (SOUTHERN VERMONT/WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS AREA) provide information, and address citizen concerns about Vermont Yankee operations.
