Dear Ms. Casey:

CHAI Development Corporation d/b/a Mobile Testing (lic. no. 48-24566-01) and MNC, Inc d/b/a Metropolitan Imaging Center (lic. no. 48-32008-01) are both requesting an exemption to 10CFR 35.70.b.

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10CFR 35.70.b states that "A licensee shall survey with a radiation detection instrument at least once each week all areas where radiopharmaceuticals or radiopharmaceutical waste is stored."

However, there can be calendar weeks in which no activity occurs at a given site. Under the current regulation, the licensee is required to dispatch a person to the site solely for the purpose of this survey.

It needs to be noted that both licensees are complying with all regulations. In this case, end of the day surveys are performed. Despite this, the regulation demands a return to the site again during an "off" week to perform a redundant survey.

The licensees understand the purpose of the regulation. It is suited for nominal or high volume sites. It is not warranted in low volume sites. There are safety concerns: the risk of the staff during travel to reproduce an additional survey. There are resource concerns: the cost of staff and administration is a burden without any gain in safety (or compliance).

Your consideration in this matter is appreciated.

CHAI Development Corporation d/b/a Mobile Testing (license no. 48-24566-01) and MNC, Inc. d/b/a Metropolitan Imaging Center (license no. 48-33008-01) are both requesting an exemption to 10CFR35.70.b.

This letter is a clarification/addendum to the 4/3/98 letter.

- 1) We are currently following the appropriate sections of 10CFR35 which deal with mobile operations.
- 2) Our request concerns seldom used, licensed, fixed site locations. I confused the situation in the 4/3/98 letter by using the words "satellite licensed locations" which has one meaning for me, but has a different implication for the NRC.

Again, specifically, we have a licensed, fixed site whose scheduled activity is subject to a wide variance of scheduled activity. We want to completely satisfy all safety concerns, and have submitted a detailed proposal.

I hope this clarifies our position, I look forward to your thoughtful consideration.

A preliminary review of your letter dated 4/3/98 revealed that insufficient information was provided to consider your request for exemption. Please provide the information requested below explicitly and completely so that we may continue to process your request.

- State why you are requesting the exemption, i.e., justify your position.
- Describe alternative procedures and compensatory safety measures as necessary to provide an equivalent level of health and safety as the regulation for which the exemption is being requested.
- Provide us with a statement of assurance that consideration of all reasonable alternatives for complying with the regulation has been exhausted.
- 4. What do you mean by "satellite ...locations?" Are you referring to temporary job sites? If so, 10 CFR 35.80 would apply and you can't leave dose calibrator reference sealed sources and radwastes behind at TJS's. Therefore, no need to request exemption.

John said he is requesting exemption for the other permanent facilities on each license that he doesn't visit every week, when patients are not scheduled. He complies with 35.80 for temporary job sites, that is not a problem. He will respond and clarify the above 4 items better.

CHAI Development Corporation d/b/a Mobile Testing (lic. no 48-24566-01) and MNC, Inc a/b/a Metropolitan Imaging Center (lic. no 48-33008-01) are both requesting an exemption to 10CFR 35.70.b.

10CFR 35.70.b. states that "A licensee shall survey with a radiation detection instrument at least once each week all areas where radiopharmaceuticals or radiopharmaceutical waste is stored."

This is prudent and appropriate for many licensees where there is daily or near daily activity. Currently, the above two licensees are in compliance.

However, there are selected instances which make the specific regulation as stated to be a hardship and possibly unnecessary:

- There can be occasions at satellite licensed locations when no activity is received or used during a calendar week. The licensee has to travel to the site for the sole purpose of a redundant survey, as a survey is performed prior to leaving the site on each date of service.

- There can be occasions, due to absence of authorized users (vacations, meetings, etc) at smaller entities, when no activity is scheduled during a week. Again, surveys are performed on each date of service. It appears redundant to schedule expensive technical help to perform a weekly survey during this time of no activity.

The licensees have considered many alternatives. Certainly there are scheduling and economic burdens associated with the current compliance. There are also safety concerns because of travel. There is no gain in radiation safety. An alternative is suggested: relief from the regulation with a survey at least quarterly (in addition to any date of service).

This provides an equivalent measure of safety. Physical inventory of sources and dose calibrator linearities are performed quarterly.

There is an element of logic: Surveys are performed on the date of service. Checks for removable contamination are made weekly. The area is documented to be at background levels. If there is no activity received or used during an arbitrary calendar week, then there is no need for a survey. This minor concern was probably not anticipated in the original rulemaking.
