Facility: Abbott Laboratories, North Chicago, Illinois License No. 12-621-3 PACKAGES CONTAINING IODINE 125 DAMAGED IN TRANSIT Subject: IN HIGHLAND PARK, ILLINOIS, ON OCTOBER 4, 1976 The licensee informed IE: III by telephone at 10:20 a.m. on October 5, 1976, that a number of radioactive diagnostic kits had fallen from a carrier's vehicle in Highland Park, Illinois at approximately 7:30 p.m. on October 4, 1976. A total of seven packages containing less than 100 microcuries of I-125 were recovered by the Highland Park police and subsequently picked up by the licensee. Licensee personnel surveyed the police vehicle and the officer who had handled the packages and no activity was detected. Licensee personnel also surveyed the roadway where the packages were recovered during the night and detected no activity. The licensee determined the exact route of the carrier's ehicle and conducted a physical search of the route during daylight on October 5, 1976. As of 1:05 p.m. on October 5, 1976, the licensee reported approximately 31 microcuries of iodine-125 are still unaccounted for. The iodine is contained in small glass and/or plastic vials which contain from one to four microcuries each. The shipping departments of both the licensee and the carrier are continuing their review of shipping documents in an effort to identify the total number of packages unaccounted for. Search conditions have been hampered due to almost continuous rain in the area. The licensee has made no news release and indicated he does not plan to make a news release. He also reported that the Highland Park police indicated they did not plan to make a news release.
