Abstract

The Office of Nuclear Safety (AU-30) establishes nuclear safety requirements and expectations for U.S. Department OF Energy to ensure protection of workers and the public from the hazards associated with facility operations within the Department. The Office of Nuclear Facility Safety Programs (AU-31) within the Office of Nuclear Safety is responsible for maintaining DOE nuclear safety policy and standards primarily related to Natural Phenomena Hazards (NPH) including earthquakes, extreme winds, floods, lightning, precipitation, and volcanic eruptions. This presentation will provide a briefing status of activities related to the Department's NPH policy and standards.
