SUMMARY

The NRC continued monitoring the licensee's performance by conducting a security inspection at Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2 and 3, in accordance with Inspection Manual Chapter (IMC) 2201, Appendix C, "Generic, Special, and Infrequent Inspections." IMC 2201 Appendix C inspections for the security inspection program are designed to support the NRC goals of maintaining safety, enhancing public confidence, improving the effectiveness, efficiency and realism of the regulatory process, reducing unnecessary regulatory burden, and promoting the common defense and security.
