Dear Ms. Klug:

This is in reference to your application, dated July 31, 2020, requesting to renew NRC License No. 47-23079-01. Also, per our telephone conversation on October 16, 2020, we discussed the information below.

In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. During our conversation, we discussed that, in June 2016, the NRC issued NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Revision 2, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses, Final Report", dated June 2016. Please resubmit your application in its entirety and refer to NUREG-1556 Vol. 1, Revision 2, Appendix B, "Suggested Format for Providing Information Requested In Items 5 through 11 of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Form 313", to prepare your response to this request for additional information letter. The NRC's Public Website hyperlink <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v1/> is being provided for convenience.
2. Your application should have been signed by a management representative. During our conversation, you indicated that your title, Secretary, is a designation of a management representative. Please provide a statement confirming that you are a management representative and authorized to sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.
3. In Box 2 and in Box 3 of your application, the mailing address and the address where material will be used or possessed, respectively, is different from the mailing addresses listed on the current amendment of your license. During our conversation, you indicated that the address change was because of an address reorganization in your local area. Please provide a statement confirming the reason for the address change.
