Dear Ms. Simmons,

I am writing in response to your email request asking if C&J (now NexTier) ever possessed H-3, Co-60 or I-131 under radioactive material license 42-35277-01. I have reviewed our inventory information for all locations in the United States and have no records that H-3, Co-60 or I-131 were ever possessed or used under radioactive material license 42-35277-01.

Since I was not the radiation safety officer when C&J applied for this license, I do not know the reason that these authorizations, which were not used, were included. However, based on the inventory records and licenses for locations in California, Kansas, and Texas it appears to me that these authorizations may have been included to standardize with other licenses. H-3, Co-60 and/or I-131 were used in one or more of these agreement states.
