Thank you for contacting the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians (SMBMI), notifying us of the intent to conduct a renew and update the License Renewal Generic Environmental Impact Statement (STC-20-059), and providing us an opportunity to comment. Nuclear power is a type of technology that is unparalleled in its potential to impact the environment. Any measure leading even indirectly to the proliferation of nuclear waste should be held cognizant of those impacts.

The Cultural Resources Management Department of the SMBMI concurs with the NRC's assessment that specific and cumulative environmental impacts to biological and cultural resources cannot be made generic. SMBMI also concurs that this is also the case for impacts to minority and low-income populations and subsistence consumption. Furthermore, we recommend that the NRC does not delegate its authority to conduct non-generic environmental reviews to state or local agencies.
