SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUIRED (IF ANY) Cassandra (Sandy) Frazier, Sr. HP (Licensing), and I contacted WUSL staff via an MS Teams meeting. WUSL staff had requested information concerning whether they could provide required training for HDR and GSR staff under 10 CFR 35.610(e) remotely, or, if not, how they could apply for an exemption to allow additional flexibility in performing that training beyond the end of the calendar year. Sandy and I explained that the training required drills of emergency procedures, which would require in-person activities. WUSL typically completed this training by the end of the calendar year but might not be able to complete it by that time if the staff would have to perform drills in small groups or individually because of limitations under Covid-19 restrictions. Based on this, WUSL staff stated that they would apply for an exemption. Sandy and I provided information on how to apply for an exemption through the NRC website.
