This is in reference to your letter dated September 22, 2020, regarding an indirect transfer of control of Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-02388-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Since this action involves an indirect transfer of control between The Hospital of Central Connecticut (HOCC) and Hartford Healthcare Corporation (HHC), the September 22, 2020 letter should have been signed by senior management of both entities. Please either resubmit the September 22, 2020 letter with an additional signature from HHC senior management, or submit a second letter signed by HHC senior management that confirms that they abide by all statements and commitments made in the September 22, 2020 letter.
2. Please confirm that the September 22, 2020 letter and its attachments can be made publicly available in order to post it to the NRC website for public comment.
