General Comment

I am writing as a representative of the Piedmont Group of the Sierra Club with over 1500 members in Central Virginia.

We request that the NRC conduct a thorough Environmental Impact Study of the North Anna Power Plant before issuing a 20 year extension of the operating license.

The is study should include:

- stringent methods to assess the condition of the aging equipment,
- harvesting and laboratory testing of aged materials from North Anna and parts from decommissioned reactors,
- assessing the safety of this aging plant during an earthquake,
- assessing the ability of the earthen dam at Lake Anna to withstand a catastrophic earthquake,
- evaluating the power plant's security and evacuation plan, and
- determining if North Anna has adequate facilities for the long term storage of nuclear waste.
