In a letter to your Tribe dated October 30, 2020 (Agencywide Document Access and Management System Accession No. ML20303A205), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) explained the process and review activities for the termination of the license by the State of Wyoming and transfer of the site to the Department of Energy (DOE) for the long term care and maintenance. That letter explained that the NRC staff would review a long-term surveillance plan (LTSP) from DOE prior to activating DOE's general license for long term care.

The NRC staff is conducting both a safety and environmental review of the DOE's LTSP. As established in Title 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 51, the NRC regulation that implements the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended, the NRC is preparing an environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed action in connection with its review of the LTSP for the WNI uranium milling site.




