I further question whether there are any plans for disposal of the radioactive waste. I conclude that it is still on site in water pools which are also subject to problems if even a small seismic event were to occur.

The North Anna dam that insures the Lake Anna waters can continue to serve as coolant in the operation of the two Units is another problem that might arise if there is movement on the earthquake fault.
