Description of the Emergency Plan Changes and Summary of 50.54(q) Analysis

Vogtle Units 3 and 4 Emergency Plan Annex

The Standard Emergency Plan (SEP) Annex for Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP) Units 3 and 4 is changed to reflect a change to Table 2.2.A, "Vogtle Electric Generating Plant On-Shift Staffing."

Number of System Operators, beyond fire brigade members, assigned to each unit is changed from two to one in SNC SEP Annex for VEGP 3 and 4, Table 2.2.A.

10 CFR 50.54(q) Analysis Summary

The reduction in on-shift staffing for system operators (non-licensed) from two to one for each unit was evaluated in accordance with regulatory guidance and determined that the change did not reduce VEGP 3 and 4's capability to perform an emergency planning/response function in the event of an emergency.

Consequently, the changes continue to meet the requirements of 10 CFR 50.47(b), 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, and the changes do not reduce the effectiveness of the emergency plan.
