Mr. Saporito,

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received your September 17, 2020, 10 CFR 2.206 Petition request and initiated the screening process in accordance with Section II.A.2(d) of NRC Management Directive (MD) 8.11 "Review Process for 10 CFR 2.206 Petitions" (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML18296A043). In your submittal you requested that the NRC issue a Confirmatory Order for Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Units 3 and 4 requesting various sanctions against NextEra and several individuals acting in their official capacity. Additionally the submittal requests orders related to the review of the Turkey Point Employee Concerns Program by a third-party, the inspection of all safety-related components, and an evaluation of the licensee's Quality Control Program.

The NRC staff has screened your request out of the 2.206 Petition Process consistent with MD 8.11 Section II.A.2(d)(ii), "General Assertions and Duplicative Requests for Action under 10 CFR 2.206." The NRC has concluded that your request is a general assertion without supporting facts as it consists primarily of excerpts from various NRC documents and reports related to incidents that the NRC has already reviewed and acted upon consistent with the NRC's enforcement process.

In addition, following review in accordance with Sections II.B.1 of MD 8.11, the NRC staff concluded that that the concerns expressed in your request do not warrant immediate enforcement action.

The 2.206 Petition Process supports the NRC's safety mission by providing the opportunity for individuals with knowledge of safety issues that the NRC staff may be unaware of at NRC licensed facilities. We greatly appreciate your interest and support of the NRC's safety mission.
