I have reviewed the licensee's request dated 10/15/2020 pertaining to removal of locations of use, hospital name change and RSO change, removal of material and authorized use.

In a signed (by Gregory Peckham) and dated letter, please provide the following information:

1. Please confirm that the hospital name change does not involve a transfer of control as described in NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, which is available at <https://www.nrc.gov/docs/ML1618/ML16181A003.pdf>.
2. Please provide background information regarding the name change. An online search for Bixby Hospital indicates that the hospital was closed. In September 2020, the new ProMedica Charles and Virginia Hickman Hospital was opened. Was the old building demolished and a new building constructed? What is the reason for a name change?
3. Please provide the last leak test results for the sources that were shipped to Hearlight Pharmacy Services.
4. Please provide confirmation/acknowledgement document/letter from Heartlight Pharmacy Services (Ohio license no. 0230000004) that the sealed sources were received (the recipient should list the sources that were received).

Please provide the information by November 30, 2020. You may submit your response directly to me via email.
