Dear Mr. Orlikowski and Ms. Cender:

Our sincere thanks to your office and U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") staff for their assistance with the above Licenses.

Consistent with our discussion on November 24, 2020, we are advising the NRC of the status of, and our commitments with respect to, the pending indirect changes of control related to Cleveland-Cliffs Inc. ("Cleveland-Cliffs") acquisition of certain specified Arcelor Mittal SA subsidiaries ("Transaction"), each such subsidiary an NRC Licensee (collectively, "AMUSA" or the "Licensees"). For ease of reference, the license numbers and the available ADAMS Accession Numbers for these pending requests are included in the table below.

On October 30, 2020, we also submitted a notice of indirect change in control for License Number GL-704409 with regard to Licensees I/N Tek L.P. and I/N Kote L.P. The Licensees understand that a public comment period may not be required for that general license, but include it in the list in the interest of completeness and transparency.

Subsequent to our discussion, we have confirmed that the closing (the "<u>Closing</u>") of the Transaction is expected to occur on or about December 9, 2020. The Closing advances important U.S. economic objectives, particularly during the COVID-19 public health and economic crisis.

We appreciate NRC's accommodation of this Closing, consistent with the fact that NRC's focus is on the health and safety aspects, not on the financial intricacies, of transactions. *See* NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, p. 3-2. We expressly acknowledge that NRC approval of the indirect changes in control associated with the above Licenses requiring such approval will follow the 30-day public comment periods related to each such materials License. *See* NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2014-08, Revision 1, p. 3.

This correspondence also confirms that the Closing will not result in a change to the Taxpayer Identification Numbers (TINs) for any of the Licensees. Likewise, the Closing will not result in a name change for any of the Licensees, although such name changes are expected in the near future.
