**SUBJECT: CONSENT TO INDIRECT CHANGE OF CONTROL FOR HULL & ASSOCIATES, LLC, NRC LICENSE NO. 34-24957-02**

Dear Mr. Zakrzewski:

By letters dated June 29, 2020 and December 17, 2020, Hull & Associates, LLC, submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for consent to an indirect change of control of NRC Materials License No. 34-24957-02. Your letters are available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession Nos. ML20188A365 and ML20352A332.

Based on the information you provided, we understand that as a result of a proposed sale between Hull & Associates, LLC, and National EC Services, LLC, control of Hull & Associates, LLC, will be indirectly transferred to National EC Services, LLC. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensed name, licensed materials, persons using the license material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify this office promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the transfer agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an administrative amendment to your NRC license to reflect the transaction (e.g., the licensee's name in the license), if necessary. If this planned transfer agreement has not been consummated within 30 days of the date of this letter, please notify us in writing.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of *the Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 51.22(c).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice and Procedures," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's ADAMS.
