Dear Dr. Speidel:

In the letter dated September 28, 2020, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the information provided. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facilities located at 1390 Highway 61 South, Ste. 2300, Crystal City, Missouri, and 3844 S. Lindbergh Blvd., Ste. 220, St. Louis, Missouri, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 24-32650-01 is hereby terminated.
