Per the referenced letter dated July 23, 2020, NRC issued an apparent violation of 10CFR50.9(a), Completeness and Accuracy of Information, when mechanics at Turkey Point recorded inaccurate information in a work order package associated with required inspection and maintenance of a safety-related check valve [EA-20-043].

In response to the apparent violation, FPL requested to participate with the NRC in the Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) process. The ADR meeting with the NRC was held on November 17, 2020. FPL and the NRC could not come to an agreement through the ADR process. As a result, FPL is requesting to participate in a Pre-decisional Enforcement Conference (PEC), as allowed by the NRC Enforcement Policy.
